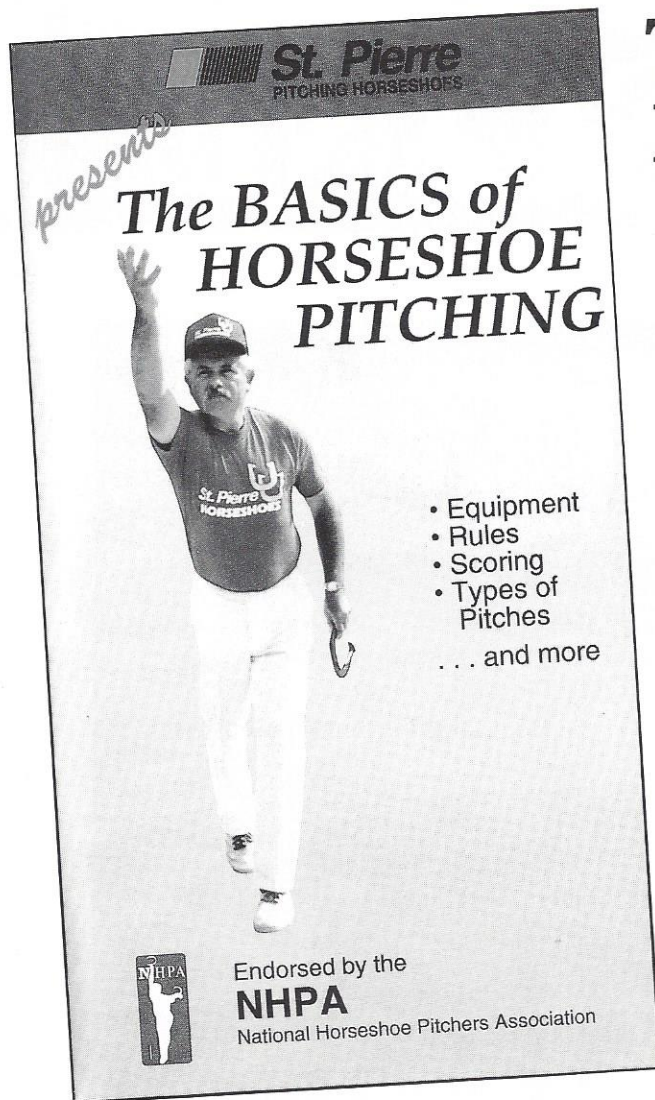

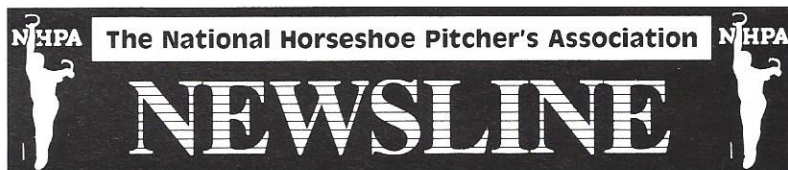

President's Message

The Pioneer Horseshoe Club of Syracuse, New York, host club of the 1994 World Tournament, has the thanks of the NHPA for the outstanding work and facilities they provided for this year's event at their State Fairgrounds. Not in recent memory have we seen as many host club members always around ready to assist in any possible way. Thanks also to the on-site assistance of a representative of the Sports Development Group from the Syracuse Chamber of Commerce. His assistance was invaluable in several areas, especially getting everything set up for each and every awards presentation.

Unfortunately, the pitchers themselves were not so cooperative and eager to help. We witnessed the greatest display of apathy toward keeping score and judging as can be remembered. The first 3 days of the tournament were especially tough, as pitching shifts were ready to start and 25 or 30 scorekeepers' chairs sat empty. There were plenty of bodies in the stands but it took a lot of pleading to get people down and into a chair. Often, we started pitching without some of the chairs filled and only one judge, sometimes two, for forty courts. We were indoors and out of the sun. It was not hot or uncomfortable so why not help out? Whatever the reason, it was not a good display of sportsmanship by the members and this applied to all levels of pitchers from the low to the high percentages. As usual, there were a handful of helpers that were always there to be counted on to keep score, judge, run scoresheets or otherwise assist. These are the same people we can count on year after year. While their ranks are small, their contributions are large.

It is the opinion of this office that every pitcher should know how to keep score and do so correctly by NHPA rules. It's pathetic to see some of the scoresheets that are turned in. With the proper recording procedure printed on the top of every NHPA scoresheet, nearly 50% of all those turned in over the course of the tournament are in some foreign scoring language. The problem starts at home with the club or charter. It is apparent that many aren't teaching pitchers how to keep score and don't care if it's done right. So many times a scorekeeper, when asked by a World official to decipher their manner of scoring, will say, "that's the way we do it at home." Obviously, some folks at home don't care about doing things correctly and it shows up as a real problem and embarrassment when they come to the World.

At the convention of delegates in Syracuse, it was mentioned by one that entering the World tournament "is a right of membership." That comment came about when we were discussing the possibility of having to limit entries given that we had a fixed number of days and courts on which to play and following a format voted on by the delegates. Even the members at home who don't know how to keep score realize court and time restraints are reasons why entry limits are imposed at many local tournaments. If it's OK at home, why not at the World where the number of days to play and the courts available are fixed by the signed contract with the host. Add to that the format and number of games pitched by each entrant now being decided by the delegates and you have the potential for a tournament that can't be properly scheduled within the given restraints of time, courts and format.

Convention Highlights

The Sunday, July 31 meeting of charter delegates convened at approximately 8:15 a.m. in the International Pavilion on the New York State Fairgrounds. Thirty six NHPA charters seated delegates representing 136 votes on all issues. Canada seated one delegate voting on the 1996 World Tournament site only. On this basis, it would take 91 votes, a 2/3 majority, to pass any bylaw proposal, but before voting got underway, one delegation of 3 left the meeting reducing the needed vote to 89. The 1996 World site and election of officers needed only a simple majority.

For the entire week before the convention, three sites bidding for the 1996 World had been engaged in very active and competitive promotion, each soliciting support for their bid through attractive displays of facilities and knowledgeable site representatives who were exuberant in extolling the qualities of their location. In the end, it was no contest as Gillette, Wyoming won the 1996 World with unexpected ease. So mark your calendars now for the expected dates of July 14-28, 1996, at the Cam-Plex indoor facility. Thanks to Tampa, Florida, and Kitchner, Ontario Canada, for their bids. We hope they were enthused enough to one day bid again.

Only a few of the 38 bylaw proposals brought much dis-

cussion. Significant ones worth individual mention were #1, the changing of Junior age limits which passed; #12 to allow military personnel and their families to play in the State Championship where they are stationed or reside passed; #14 to allow all 30' pitchers a playing opportunity in all sanctioned tournaments passed; #21 to change the method of voting for NHPA Officers failed; #24 to change the method of voting on a World Tournament site failed; #27 to change the Elders division (men or women 70+ years old) to Elder Men only failed; #32 to allow, when necessary, a limit on World entries failed. Complete voting results are elsewhere in this issue.

NHPA 4th Vice President Bonnie Seibold was returned to office by acclamation as she ran unopposed. In what was expected to be the only exciting race, Secretary-Treasurer Donnie Roberts won by a large margin over candidate Marvin Grubb. It was 2nd VP Barry Chapelle who actually caused the delegates to stir when he announced that he was withdrawing his name for re-election. With no other candidate running, Barry's announcement by NHPA policy, threw the office open to nominations from the floor. The delegates were given a 10-15 minute break to caucus as possible

candidates among the assembly of delegates were sought. When the meeting was reconvened, four nominations came from the floor, one of which was rejected because the person was not in attendance. The other 3 people, Jim Shilling of Indiana, George Nick of Minnesota and Casey Sluys of California were available to accept their nominations. It took two ballots before Casey Sluys was elected over George Nick in a close vote.

Near the end of the meeting, the delegates had an opportunity to discuss a proposed format of play for the 1995 World in Perry, Georgia. They gave overwhelming acceptance to continuing the 16 person group format of this year with the best percentages of all classes within a division being moved up to play 40 point round robins for the World Championships. More on this in the next issue.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:30 p.m. in plenty of time for the banquet that evening. All in all, as NHPA President and meeting chairman, I felt the convention went very well with some good decisions made and a couple that only time will tell. Thanks to all who took part.

Syracuse University, a member of the Big East Conference, is not known for its hospitality at the Carrier Dome. But for 2 weeks this Seton Hall grad felt at home all over town. Well, almost.

Great job by the host Pioneer Horseshoe Club. Dave Harnden, the club public relations PRO, worked tirelessly to develop media contacts for the NHPA Press Room. Radio, newspapers and TV were very responsive to his persistent calls.

Every World Tournament has some nice surprises which become unfor-

gettable moments. In Men's Division C2, for example, Ron Ballinger finished in a 4-way tie for 1st place with 11 wins, 4 losses. Ron pitched superbly, under pressure, in the ladder playoffs to finish on top with a 13/4 record and 52.65%. Earlier in the tournament, Nate Shelton fashioned a 14/1 record and 37% average to take top honors in Division N1. Both of these pitchers are members of the West Essex Handicap Horseshoe Pitching Club, in New Jersey (Sanction #89-C-36). Ballinger, a lefthanded (¾ turn) pitcher credits his success to eight years of state, national and club competition. Shelton is in his second year of competition and credits his quick success to the highly acclaimed video "The Basics of Horseshoe Pitching" which taught him how to pitch a 1¼ turn.

There were also some unforgettable moments off the courts. I sat next to a lady spectator. She had a book on her lap. As we watched her husband win a come-from-behind cliffhanger, I exclaimed: "Wow! Isn't it exciting? She said, "Oh, yes! It's the best book I ever read!" See y'all in Georgia!

Delegate Voting on Bylaw Proposals

Thirty eight proposed changes to NHPA bylaws were discussed and voted on at the Syracuse business meeting of charter delegates. To detail

how every charter voted on all 38 proposals would be very time and space consuming. Since most are really interested in only what passed and

what didn't, the following synopsis is given. 133 delegate votes were represented. It took 89 votes to meet the 2/3 majority needed to pass. Refer to the proposed changes as written in the March/April 1994 *Newsline*.

Proposal 2 passed 104-29 with amended wording to define that only official NHPA business meeting decisions have to be put in published minutes and nothing related to member names or items of confidence need be mentioned.

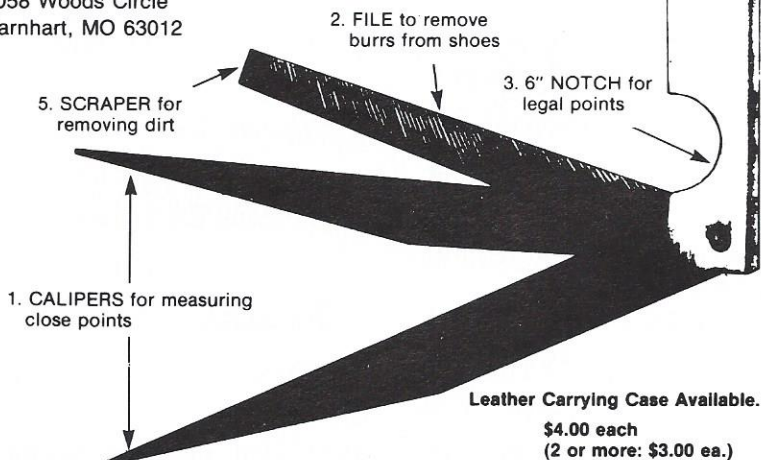

The Charters of Arizona, Mississippi and Tennessee presented delegate lists but the representatives did not show up to be seated. Other charters not mentioned here or above did not submit delegate lists as required by NHPA bylaws and thus were not represented at the business meeting.

Regional Director's Report

The Regional Directors meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m., Friday, July 29, with 15 charters represented and 21 in attendance. Three items were on the agenda for discussion and then the floor was opened up to open discussions.

Both candidates for NHPA Secretary Treasurer, Donnie Roberts and Marvin Grubb attended and were given time to take the floor and state their qualifications and answer questions.

First item on the agenda was the revised Regional Directors and Assistant Regional Directors Guidelines. The appointment of ARDs as worded in the Guideline was questioned as to why it must be approved by the 5th V.P. It was pointed out that ARD appointment approval is needed in order to maintain some control on the number of ARDs each RD has.

Compensation for ARD miscellaneous expenses was also questioned. It was pointed out by NHPA President, Dave Loucks, who sat in to answer questions, of the importance of sending in receipts for all NHPA related expenses. ARD NHPA related expenses can be submitted to the 5th V.P. for approval and a wording change will be looked into under Article VI Section 2 to add ARD compensation.

Next on the agenda was the NHPA patch program. I voiced some concern as to the number of patches that I anticipate to have remaining at the end of the year. After much discussion, for or against having the year on the patches, it was approved by a voice vote to keep the year on all patches and that I will attempt to cut down and control the patch program to try and avoid the expense of unused patches.

The sanctioning of courts was then discussed. It was brought up that most Charters now require the courts to be sanctioned before you can have a sanctioned tournament on them. There seemed to be some confusion on temporary courts, such as those used at the World Tournament, because they do not meet all the requirements listed on the court sanction form. I stated that I would look into rewriting the form to cover temporary courts as well as any new rule changes. I am also planning on listing all courts that have been sanctioned by Charter and update that list with any new sanctions.

Open discussion began with shoe checking. Better control was said to be needed after the first day of pitching. John Decker stated that he had

made some spot checks on the courts on the second and third day and found no one using shoes they had not checked in. The need to get more Junior involved in horseshoes was also discussed. Earl Waggy stated that he has been working directly with the schools in his area and the program has been very well received.

Before the meeting closed I announced that Paul Stewart of North Carolina, would be the recipient of the Regional Director of the Year Award, and it would be presented at the NHPA Awards Banquet. Meeting was adjourned at 3:15 p.m.

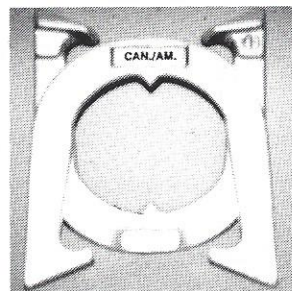
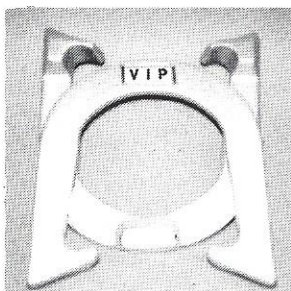

Our annual meeting was held the afternoon of July 30, at the New York State Fairgrounds, with representatives of 15 NHPA charters present. The first topic of discussion was the old subject of 30 footers versus 40 footers.

One state has a real problem with mixed tournaments as nearly all of their top average pitchers are short distance pitchers. There seems to be no universal solution that will please everyone. Some areas have no problem running mixed tournaments. Other areas run classes of 30 footers with a wide difference in averages and use a handicap system to try and even up the competition within a class.

Tournament directors have a great deal of flexibility in how they will conduct a tournament. However, under the new NHPA Rules pamphlet, one of the duties of tournament directors is to advise would-be entrants of the type of event that will be held and to furnish any other information the contestant needs. There should be no last minute surprises.

The NHPA universal score calling system is still not being used everywhere. Those present in our meeting seemed in agreement that the charter officers need to continue to educate the pitchers in their own states.

Casey Sluys, of Northern California, shared a pamphlet he uses to introduce new members to the sport and to his local club. It tells them how to enter tournaments, advises them of proper court etiquette, tells them how to read the tournament schedule and understand the different classifications of tournaments held in their area. It also advises them what to take in the way of equipment, monetary needs and even refreshments. A truly helpful piece of literature for a brand new member.

Marvin Grubb reported that Florida has a packet of material they provide for new members. It seems some charters tend to forget the new people as soon as the dues are paid. We must continue to encourage their interest and make them feel a part of our association, so they will want to continue their participation year after year.

It was a Finals Day at the World Tournament, but Donnie Roberts was able to stop by for a few moments, so the chairman introduced the candidates for the office of NHPA Secretary/Treasurer. Marvin Grubb and Donnie Roberts each gave a short speech to the assembly.

The question was raised about giving cash prizes to junior pitchers. Many states do not require entry fees from juniors and do not award them prizes of any monetary value. This is the policy recommended by the NHPA. If prizes of monetary value are awarded to juniors, it is recommended that a trust fund be established for them until they reach 18 years of age.

Someone asked if all states had a publicity director and if that person was having any luck? We really did not have answers to that question.

The suggestion was made that the NHPA finance a study of the existing programs available for charter secretaries and charter statisticians and come up with programs that included the best parts of each incorporated into a standard program for secretaries and a standard program for statisticians. These programs could be offered at a modest sum to all interested charters. If something like this was offered to the charters, it was felt that reporting to the NHPA could be done in an easier and more timely manner.

Those charters already having computers may already have programs, but some are still looking for better programs. Those charters not yet having computers, might be more willing to obtain one if they knew the necessary computer programs would be easily available to them. It was felt that since the NHPA has a financial excess well into the six digit figures, the NHPA can afford to undertake this project. There was a further suggestion that this idea be presented to the NHPA Executive Council at the 1994 Convention the next day. (Chairman's note: This was done and seemed to have a great deal of support from the assembled delegates.

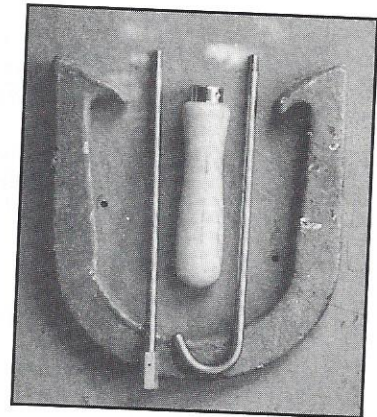
The question was raised concerning what various states do with no-shows at tournaments? It appeared

that most have no harsh penalties. At pre-paid tournament, the entry fee is kept. One state makes the no-show pay an entry fee, if they reserved a spot and didn't show, before they can pitch in another tournament.

The idea of color coding scoresheets for individual classes at tournaments was mentioned as an aid to scoresheet checkers and statisticians. Where different colors are not available, you can take different colors of markers and color code some white scoresheets. This system does speed up the work of the tournament statistician. When a computer was being used, I believe someone said that even the round robin cards for each class were color coded. Having used color coding personally for many years, I can verify that it is a big help.

There being no further discussion, the meeting was adjourned.

New Faces Among 6 World Champions Crowned in Syracuse

1994 World Champions were crowned in six divisions this year and four of them stepped into the spotlight for the first time. We had new first time winners in the Seniors, Elders and Junior Boys and Girls categories. While the crown returned to former winners in the Men and Women divisions, there was a great deal of excitement among the spectators and apprehension among some players about the innovative sudden death play-off format that had been decided on for this year. In fact, there had been a late 11th hour petition circulated among the 80 top Men and Women participants in hopes that the Tournament Committee would revert to round-robin play for the finals. It didn't happen. To their credit, the Tournament Committee stayed with the format that had been published and sudden death proved to be a real crowd pleaser.



MEN

Walter Ray Williams Jr. from Stockton, California won his sixth Men's World Championship by winning 4 straight sudden death games in the 76th Annual NHPA World Horseshoe Pitching Tournament.

Nine men had qualified from the top 48 to enter sudden death. In the first round there would be 3 games with the losers getting \$500 each and the winners advanced to the next round, each time getting closer to the final game worth \$4,000 to the winner and \$2,500 for second place.

Seeded #4, Walter Ray faced #9 seed, Mark Baumann of Minnesota. Mark took a 3 point lead in the first inning and a 13-0 lead after ten shoes. The 13 point lead still held for Mark as he led 19-6 at 28 shoes. But it was here that Walter Ray got tough. In the next 36 shoes Walter tossed 33 ringers to win the game 40-25.

Round two found Walter Ray up against Kevin Cone who was the #6 seed and had disposed of #7 seed Phil Fleshman in round one. This game was destined to go 102 shoes before it was over and be a real test of Walter Ray's grit. Walter fell behind early and struggled to stay with Kevin much as he did in his game with Baumann. At 66 shoes, Kevin, pitching at an 87% clip had forged what seemed like an unsurmountable 31-8 lead. Then Walter Ray turned things around. He proceeded to end the game just as he had in round one, by throwing 33 ringers in the next 36 shoes while Kevin struggled under the pressure. At 102 shoes, Walter had overcome a 23

point deficit and won the game 41-37.

Round 3 found Walter Ray against #2 seed, Brian Simmons of Maine. Again, Walter fell behind but never by more than 6 points and at 58 shoes, he took the lead at 22-21 as Simmons began to fade from the 90% average he had pitched for the first 50 shoes. In the end, it was Williams winning 41-32.

Round four, the final game for the World Championship matched Walter Ray Williams Jr. against 17 year old Jim Walters from Troy, Ohio. Jim, who was seeded #8 in the finals and had just graduated to the Men's Division after five consecutive years as the undefeated Junior Boy's Champion, had obviously become the crowd favorite. Like Williams, Jim had to win his first 3 matches to get to this final game. And, he did so in a fashion that matched Walter Ray. In round one, Walters disposed of Art Tyson in an exciting 42-31 come from behind victory. In round two, Rick Cale fell to Walters and in round three, it was defending World Champion Alan Francis who finally lost to Jim 38-41 in 108 shoes, the longest game of the tournament.

The stage was set and the final match was on. Williams again fell behind 3-0 but quickly turned things to his favor. Neither pitcher was showing the consistency of their previous 83-84% three game average and it became a guessing game...who who would get the hot streak? A string of 19 ringers in 20 shoes built a lead of 36-14 for Williams at 42 shoes and at 60 shoes, the shortest game of the finals, Williams had won his 6th Men's World Title.



WOMEN

The Women also engaged in a sudden death shootout with 6 players from the initial top 32 qualifying for the finals. Like the men, losers of the first round would get \$500 apiece with the winners moving on toward the final game that would pay \$3,500 to the champion and \$2,000 for second place.

Sue Snyder of Grandview, Indiana won her 2nd World Championship as she easily rolled over her 3 opponents while averaging 90.11% for her games. Seeded #3, Sue defeated #6 seed and 5-time World Champion Phyllis Negaard in round one by a score of 42-7 pitching 88.46%. Next came #2 seed Bev Nathe who lost 43-15 as Snyder threw a blistering 74 shoe game of 91.89%. The final championship game would pit either #5 seed Lois Webster of Kentucky or #2 seed Diane Cantin of Canada against Sue as she waited for the outcome of their game. Lois won the game and with it the right to pitch against her good friend Sue Snyder for the Championship.

The final game started more slowly than the others as both players were pitching 75% and tied 15-15 at 20 shoes. It was here that Sue got hot and ran away with the game. 24 straight ringers and 35 out of the last 36 won the World Title for Sue as she beat Lois 40-15.

No one in either the Men or Women finals was more impressive or had such a hot hand as Sue Snyder. When asked if she was surprised by her overwhelming victories, the usually very modest Snyder confidently replied, "I really earned this title...I've been throwing 500 practice shoes every day preparing for this champion-

ship." No one could doubt that on this occasion, the old cliché "practice makes perfect" said it all as Sue hit 164 ringers out of 182 shoes pitched for her 90.11% average.

SENIORS

There was a happy Merlin Potts in Syracuse, following his victory in the Seniors championship group. He was observed clutching his trophy and smiling broadly as he received congratulations and handshakes from his well wishers.

Potts, from Leonardville, Kansas, closed with a 13-2 record and 66.17% to outlast Canada's Howard Weitzel (11-1/2-3-1/2, 66.33) with 1960 World Champion Don Titcomb, Kentucky (11-4, 65.50) finishing third. Don was the Intermediate Champion in 1988. Three-time Elders Champion and Senior winner in 1988, Spud Napier, was fourth (11-4, 62.67).

The reason for the happy Merlin Potts was his first world title. Merlin pitched in the Men's Championship class beginning in 1966. He missed the top class only 4 times until he entered lower classes. He was in the "B" prelims in 1981, was 9th in the Men's Class "A" in 1991, 4th in the Intermediates in 1992, and 10th in the Seniors last year with a 6-9 record and 56.6%.

ELDERS - 30 FOOT

Pete Rebman from Alma, Nebraska moved into the *Elite* Championship group this year and promptly added the Elders 30 foot title to his Class "B" crown of last year.

In 1993 he had an 11-0 record and 64.77%. This year Pete topped his

closing percentage to 68.33 defeating Missouri's Don Harris, 40-25, in a playoff to win the title. Harris had a tournament high percentage of 72.19.

The 78 year old Nebraska Cornhusker pitcher gradually changed to the 30-foot range 3 years, moving from a 1-1/4 to 3/4 turn in the process.

BOYS

Vance Harren from Badger, Minnesota overcame the challenge from 12 year old newcomer Damien Moore, Seguin, Texas and veteran Lenwood Conner, Jr., Virginia to win the Boys Championship. Vance closed with a 13-1 record, two games in front of Moore, three ahead of Conner.

It has been an uphill battle for the 17 year old. Harren has competed in the championship group for 5 years in the shadow of 5-time winner Jim Walters from Ohio. His ringer percentage has steadily increased from 59.6 in 1990 to the 1994 tournament high of 75.89.

Before we close the books on this pitching trio, it is interesting to note that the "Big Three" will be back next year. Expect another battle for the title at Perry, Georgia in 1995. Please be alert to the fact that Moore's birthdate is September 15, 1981 and his 75.18 ringer percentage is bound to improve each year. Conner's closing figure was 73.39.

GIRLS

It has been an uphill battle for Heidi Sternberg, one of many Richfield Wisconsin Sternbergs who frequent World Tournaments.

Heidi's quest for a World title climaxed this year at Syracuse when the dedicated 17 year old junior defeated defending champion Crystal Curtis from Canada, 40-18 in a playoff.

A 4-year program for Heidi resulted in steady improvement from a 52.40 percentage in 1992 to 54.31 last year and a cool 65.31 in Syracuse. She finished no lower than fifth the last four years.

Practice resulted in success and with so many family members available, it has been a given that at least one Sternberg entry would grab the brass ring. Sister Heather finished sixth this year and mother Lorraine won both the Class "B" and "C" titles in 1987. Lorraine moved up to the championship women this year.

Heidi could be found every day at the practice courts, symbolizing the work of a champion, regardless of your pitching class. And she will be back next year to defend her title.

After playing four 40 point games, winners Williams and Negaard took

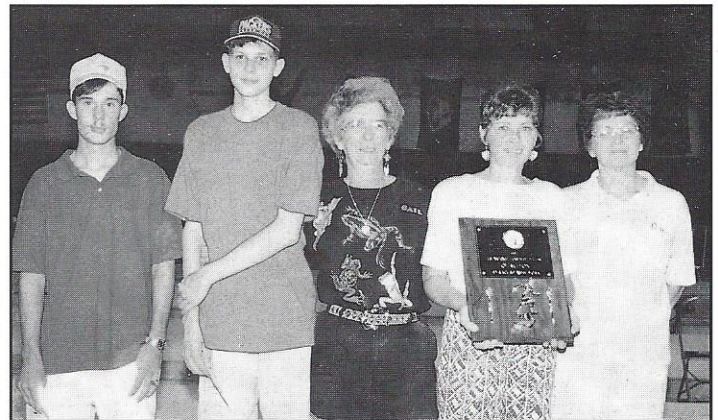
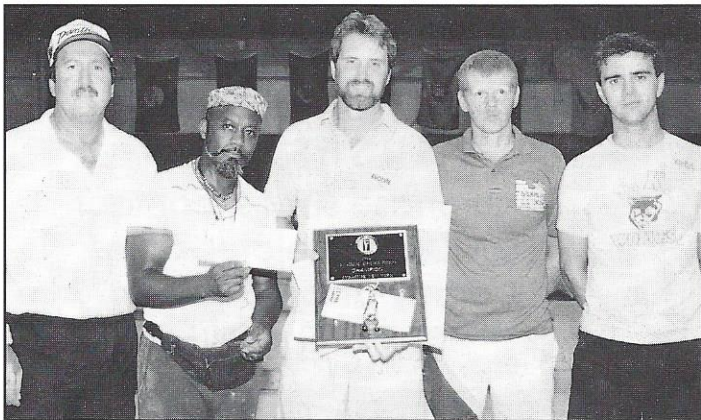
home \$250 each plus a very nice plaque from the NHPA. Each pitcher received a cash prize with a total of \$1400 being awarded, \$700 per group.
