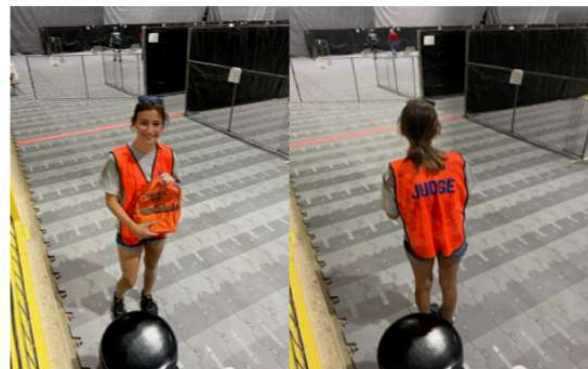
JUNIORS, CADETS NEWS
